We are struggling with frustration about the information flow that you mention in your email. We are in regular contact with the County and the State to try to obtain more current and relevant information.

I can share the latest information the Village received yesterday, which is that there are 19 confirmed positive cases in Scarsdale. We recognize that this information is limited and dated.

Please know that the policies that have been put in place by the Governor are effective. Please wash your hands and use hand sanitizer frequently, maintain social distancing and practice other recommendations put in place by the CDC and State and County Health Departments - the recommendations are effective at slowing the spread of the virus.

Dear Mayor Samwick:

Thank you for your letter of March 20th.

I am writing because I am frustrated by the lack of information coming from Westchester County about the course of the virus here, and hope you might be able to move the County Executive to provide more information. I see the daily counts of coronavirus in Westchester, but I haven't seen a breakdown of cases by municipality, nor any information on how many of the cases require hospitalization, where the deaths have occurred, how our hospitals are handling the present and anticipated load of cases. Not knowing what is going on locally makes me anxious; what I know, I can deal with, what I don't know I can only imagine. I have called the NYS and Westchester coronavirus telephone numbers and checked their websites and have been unable to get anything other than the Westchester total number of cases. If the information is there, I haven't found it.

I would be very grateful if you could do something to get this information reported on a regular basis.
