Hi Benny and Mayor Jon. The conditions of Fox Meadow Road (from Butler Road to Highland Way) continue to deteriorate and I am embarrassed every time I drive along the road. More than 70 repaired potholes. Debris covering many areas of the road. More than 25 blue and yellow spray painted lines and markings. Uneven road conditions that fill with water following rain storms. Uneven and completely missing curbing. Remained unfilled potholes. Looks terrible. Is embarrassing. Is dangerous. As agreed with 60 of my neighbors (signed petition + 100 pictures attached again as a reference), the time is now to finally pave this section of Fox Meadow Road. I have been emailing and calling the Village for over 3 years and hope that once and for all, this busy section of road in our Village can finally be paved. For many people, it is an entry point into the Village. I have tried and tried to raise this to the attention of the Village, but time after time, have been told 'maybe next year' or 'maybe the year after next' ...and this despite agreement from the Village that road condition is poor. I hope to get a commitment from the Village that this area of Fox Meadow Road will finally be repaired this coming spring. Thank you so much for your attention in this matter.
