Hi Cynthia,

I hope you and your family are and remain well.

Over the past couple of weeks, NYS has waffled on their interpretation of landscaping as an essential business. At present, a state agency issued guidance indicating that all landscaping services are essential, including both routine maintenance as well as aesthetic enhancements. However, over the past week, or so, there has been continuing discussion between Westchester County and the Governor's Office on the topic. It is possible that the guidance may change. If it does, we will provide an update through our Twitter account, @ScarsdaleGov<https://twitter.com/ScarsdaleGov>, as well as other communication outlets.

So, for now, landscaping is authorized and workers should maintain social distancing. The local leaf blower ban goes into effect June 1<<u>x-apple-data-detectors://17</u>> (and NYS has indicated that leaf blowers have not been classified as a COVID-19 risk factor).

The Village expects to continue to follow State and County guidance for landscaping.
