Dear Mr. Mayor,

We have been homeowners at 3 Hickory Lane for over 30 years, and are against the proposed weekly curbside pickups for the following reasons:

- 1) It will be a burden to homeowners, especially elderly homeowners, to transport recyclables to the curbside. It will be especially difficult for those of us who have longer driveways. Recyclable containers can get quite heavy during the course of a week.
