A broad analysis of a redevelopment of the Freightway site is critical to the Village's determination whether to proceed with the redevelopment - as is the process of understanding the costs associated with not proceeding with a redevelopment.

It is important to keep in mind that the development concepts that have been proposed and will be discussed on December 11th<x-apple-data-detectors://0> are very preliminary and are designed to help make a selection of a preferred developer - not necessarily to see exactly what would be built at the Freightway site.

The Board is very focused on the fiscal, school and other impacts of a redevelopment of the Freightway site and is currently in the process of evaluating the preliminary impacts with the Village's planning consultants, AKRF.

As the preferred developer refines more specific plans for the Freightway site, more extensive impacts will be studied and presented to the community. Please continue to watch for public announcements in the months ahead and note that there is much work that needs to take place before the developer is in a position to present fiscal, school and other impacts to the community for our evaluation.
