Mr. Mayor,

Hope things are well with you. My name is Cliff Seltzer. You may remember me from the East Heathcote Neighbored Association meeting a few months back. I am Vice President and was sitting next to Jeff Watiker when you joined us for our bi-annual meeting.

I wanted to thank you for hearing our concerns about the sidewalk on Heathcote road in our area and the request to park a police care near the intersection of Heathcote and Carthage to watch for cars "blowing thru" the stop signs. Both of those concerns were addressed, as I have seen police cars and noticed some paving improvements to the very beat up sidewalk.

At the same time I have one more concern to point out to you...maybe you can work your magic again. As with many key roads in Scarsdale, Heathcote road, just east of the Five Corners was dug up to make improvements on the pipes and such underneath. Although it took much longer than expected, the many areas that were worked on have finally been completed and patched. I am now wondering if and when the road may be fully repaved? Similar work on many of the major roads in the Fox Meadow area near the Village (Crane/Popham) have had similar work and the roads were completely restored. I am wondering why this would not take place for Heathcote, given the traffic it takes on. I am unsure if the village or Con Ed is responsible, but maybe you could check in, as it has become a nuisance.
