We fully support the December 2017 Scarsdale Conservation Advisory Council Sanitation Study and urge you to approve the recommendations in the report to launch weekly curbside pickup of food scrap, increase the frequency of commingled/paper recycling to once per week and site a furniture donation container at the Scarsdale Recycling Center.

As participants of the Food Scrap Municipal Pilot program from the very beginning, we were so happy to have a place to bring our food scraps to because we were doing the composting ourselves prior to this. We believe the program has been very successful and feel that having weekly curbside pickup would not only be ultra-convenient but on a broader scale, it would represent another step toward helping the entire community make being less wasteful a part of their daily lives.
