I trust that you are well. I write again to emphasize the repeated infractions that I witness at the corner of Crane Road and East Parkway and along Fox Meadow Road.

On Sunday at 12:30pm, I witnessed a resident running the Stop sign at Crane and Parkway despite the fact that a pedestrian was trying to cross.

Worse yet, this morning at 8:30am, a resident who was speeding on Fox Meadow Road, ran past a school bus, even though the bus had stopped and had all the signals on to show drivers that they cannot pass while the bus driver is collecting children. I ran behind the driver until I got her to stop and I made her aware of her egregious behavior. Then at 9:30am a resident who came by

to drop something off was almost side swiped by a speeding car.

I know that you are all very busy, but this is the 4th time in 3 years that I write to alert you about these problems. As you may be aware, in the last five years, there has been significant turnover from 1 Fox Meadow to 22 Fox Meadow. Just about every family along this stretch has kids.
