Subject: Speeding Cars on Fox Meadow Road During School Pick-up Times

Dear Mayor Hochvert, Chief Maturro, and Captain Altizio,

I trust that you are well. Over the last few years, Brice and I have written several times about speeding drivers on Fox Meadow Road between Wayside Lane and Crane Road. Today, for example at 8:10am, a driver sped right past a school bus, even though the bus driver had fully stopped the bus and had the stop sign out. This happens quite frequently.

Moreover, drivers often speed without stopping past the stop sign at Crane Road and East Parkway. Brice and I both have had cars

drive past the stop sign while we are walking across in the area designed for pedestrians. One driver even rode past the sign while Brice had both of our small children in a large stroller and was crossing the street at that corner.

Can a patrol periodically go by Fox Meadow Road at least around 8-8:15 when elementary school children are being picked up? Can the Village put a few signs up on posts reminding people that our road is not the Indianapolis 500?

I thank you for the work that you do in Scarsdale. I look forward to hearing from you.
