I am writing to you to express my support for naming the football field at the Crossways Athletic Complex "Coach Richard 'Rippy' Philipps Field." While I no longer reside in Scarsdale, I always consider it "home" mainly because of all the wonderful memories I have from my childhood. One of these special memories for me is the joy I had playing football for the middle school team coached by Rippy Philipps in the fall of 1995. Every time I visit home, without exception, I exit off of the Hutchinson River Parkway, turn onto Mamaroneck Road, and as I head to my parents' house - I drive by Crossways Field. And inevitably as I drive by Crossways Field I turn my head to the left and stare at the field for a few seconds. That joy is entirely due to Rippy.
