Subject: exit at Crane Road

Dear Mayor and Police Commissioner:

I am writing to alert you to a safety condition on the Bronx River Parkway that almost turned into a disaster for me and others last night. I was returning from Edgemont at 7:00 p.m., and I was driving south on the Bronx River, intending to get off at the left exit onto Crane Road. Although I am familiar with the roadway, it was very dark, and when my GPS told me to stay left, I mistakenly thought I had reached the exit. I have not gone back this morning to see it in the light of day, but somehow when I stayed to the left and ended up driving into oncoming northbound traffic on the highway. I was able to pull off onto the right side (I don't know what that area was), and avoid being hit. There was NO SIGNAGE whatsoever indicating to me that I was going the wrong way or that I should not exit there. Clearly, it was very easy to do, as I did it without encountering any barrier at all, and I was only fortunate that the oncoming traffic was far away enough to give me a chance to get out of the way.

This was a horribly frightening experience. I do not understand how there could have been no warning, given how simple a mistake this was to make, especially for anyone using a GPS system that may give the direction to turn a little bit ahead of time. Please assure me that you will look into this matter for the safety of all.
