I hope you and your family are well.

The information I received from the County today indicate that there are 298 positive COVID cases in Scarsdale.

Please keep in mind a few points about the numbers that are received. First, the number is cumulative from the start of the pandemic and, therefore, do not represent the number of currently positive cases. Second, the information is generated by the State and is then transmitted to the County and then to the Village and, as a result, is lagging. Lastly, the reported number of positive cases only includes those that are tested and it is reasonable to believe that a number of people have been or are currently positive and have not been tested.
