Hi Patrick,

I hope you and your family are well.

Thank you for your email.

We have been aware for quite some time that our number of positive cases is lagging and likely significantly under-represents the actual number of positive cases in the Village. Most of what you are correctly noting in your assessment of the trajectory of positive cases is simply a catch-up of the numbers. I have found that a more reliable number to track, though not precisely relevant to the Village, is the number of positive cases in the County that is issued by the State. The State data appears to be much more timely than the numbers that filter down to the Village.

The other factor I have seen in the recent numbers is the inclusion of addresses that are in Scarsdale though have other post office addresses.

My personal belief is that the leveling we are seeing in the County fairly represents the general trajectory of the Village. Unfortunately, I do not have firm numbers to back this up, but I am tracking hospitalizations at White Plains Hospital and local ambulance calls for service.
